Dear parents and carers,

We are delighted to inform you that we are planning 2 class trips, one to Dunkirk Mill and one to The Museum in the Park, in Stroud, as part of our work on local history. Our learning will be focused on the history of the Stroud area mills and the cloth making industry.

At **Dunkirk Mill**, we will spend the morning seeing the water wheel and teasing machines in action, and finding out about the mill owners. This will be a morning only trip, and we are hoping to walk there and back, so children will need **sensible footwear**, a **water** bottle, and **hat** and **sun cream** (pre-applied) if the weather is hot. If, on the day, it pours with rain, Mrs Harbord has kindly offered to ferry the children there and back.

At **The Museum in the Park**, the children will get to experience using tools and processes, similar to those used in the historic cloth making industry, to build understanding of what life was like in the past, as well as taking part in a Discovery Trail.

For this second trip, the children will need to come to school with a **healthy snack**, **packed lunch** and **water bottle** (No yoghurts or fizzy drinks please), and will need to be dressed in school uniform. We will be leaving school at 9.30am and returning before the end of the school day.

As you are aware, hiring coaches has become increasingly expensive, and so in order to keep the cost of the trips to a total donation of $\pounds 7$ per child, we would be very grateful if you could let us know if you are able to help transport members of the class to Stratford Park for the second trip. If you are able to transport, but not stay, please indicate on the form below.
